

# Workplace Based Assessment

## Program

### OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM

The WBA program offered at Sunshine Coast Health is a 12 month assessment program run as an alternative to the AMC2 Clinical Examination.

Assessments are completed at the level of PGY1/ intern. On successful completion of the program a certificate is issued by AMC providing a step towards general registration

### PROGRAM NUMBERS/INTAKES

Sunshine Coast Health aims to take up to 24 candidates throughout the year with intakes averaging every 2 months.

### ASSESSMENT DETAILS

As per AMC exam, assessments (Mini CEX, Case based discussions, In training assessments & multisource feedback) are completed covering the following disciplines: Adult Medicine, Adult Surgery, Child Health, Emergency Medicine, Mental Health & Women's Health.

### APPLYING FOR WBA

To be eligible for the WBA Program at the SCHHS you must have passed the AMC CAT MCQ and IELTS and be an employee with Sunshine Coast Health. You need to be employed as a PGY2/+ Prevocational doctor and complete a minimum of 2 x (10 week) medical terms/ rotations.

Requests for EOIs for the WBA program will be sent to current eligible (having completed 20 weeks) Sunshine Coast Health employees (with AHPRA Ltd Reg) 2 months prior to program commencement. EOI will request a completed application form, cover letter, resume, 2 referee reports & 2 satisfactory assessment forms from Sunshine Coast Health.

### COST

The WBA program at Sunshine Coast Health costs \$12,000. Payments can be made upfront or according to a payment schedule.
