Logan Hospital is easily accessible via the Logan Motorway and Pacific Motorway and is situated just 30 minutes from Brisbane City and 40 minutes from the Gold Coast.

Logan Hospital is the major health centre for one of the fastest growing regions in the state and provides a range of specialty services for children and adults. Our emergency department is one of the busiest in the state, seeing more than 100,000 presentations each year.

We have grown from a 48-bed community hospital in 1990 to a 610-bed hospital today, mirroring the rapid growth in population in the Logan region.

We provide acute medical, surgical, rehabilitation, maternity, cardiology, orthopaedics, renal and other specialty services for children and adults.

Logan Hospital is a 'digital hospital' with a fully integrated electronic medical record, supporting improvements to the quality and efficiency of healthcare services for patients and the community.

There is onsite parking at both Logan Hospital and next door at TAFE Queensland (this cost can be salary sacrificed). For those wishing to use public transport, Loganlea Train Station is located across the road from the Hospital.

## LOGAN HOSPITAL EXPANSION

Logan Hospital is undergoing one of Queensland's largest ever hospital expansion programs.

With a total capital commitment of more than a billion dollars, the expansion is a suite of major construction projects that will significantly increase the capacity of the hospital to provide more services for our community, close to home.

The Logan Hospital Expansion includes:

- » **Expansion Project Stage 1**—delivering 206 additional beds and treatment spaces
- » **Expansion Project Stage 2**—delivering 112 additional beds and treatment spaces in a new clinical services building
- » **Maternity Refurbishment Project**—a major upgrade to existing maternity and neonatal services
- » **Logan Urgent and Specialist Care Centre**—a community healthcare facility in the Meadowbrook precinct featuring a minor injury and illness centre and Women's Health specialist services
- » **Modular Medical Ward**—a new, 28-bed 'complex discharge' ward.

<b>Students in Medicine (SIM)</b>	To be eligible to work as a SIM, medical students must be in their penultimate or final year of study in a postgraduate medical program (e.g. 3rd or 4th year at UQ or Griffith; 4th or 5th year at Bond) or in their third last, penultimate or final year of studies in an undergraduate medical program (e.g. 4th, 5th or 6th year at JCU). ## REGISTRATION

Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) registration is mandatory. Medical practitioners must be eligible for AHPRA General Registration or Provisional Registration with at least minimum Level 2 Supervision. Unfortunately, Logan Hospital cannot offer positions to candidates who are Limited Registrants only eligible for Level 1 Supervision with AHPRA.
