Training and career progression

The Medical Education Unit provides support and assistance with both professional and personal matters with support of the Director of Clinical Training, Principal Medical Education Officer and Medical Education and Wellbeing Registrar.

An extensive prevocational education program is offered, including:

- ▶ Pastoral care and advocacy
- ▶ Career education including one-on-one career planning, specialty training guidance and workforce nurturing
- ▶ Evidence based prevocational doctor wellbeing education program
- ▶ Weekly intern and prevocational doctor education sessions
- ▶ Monthly grand rounds
- ▶ Prevocational doctor-focused departmental education including journal clubs, multidisciplinary team meetings, video conferenced teaching and educational sessions with tertiary facilities
- ▶ Onsite clinical skills sessions including suturing, plastering, ultrasound guided cannulation and ECG workshops
