#### Regional Medical Pathway

Rockhampton, Gladstone and Emerald are Central Queensland's lead sites for the Regional Medical Pathway (RMP), a major partnership between The University of Queensland, CQUniversity and the Central Queensland and Wide Bay Hospital and Health Services.



The RMP provides local community supported, end-to-end medical education and training designed to address workforce shortages in the Central Queensland and Wide Bay regions. This Pathway involves student placements across the education continuum and learning opportunities through pre-vocational and vocational training.

The RMP includes a variety of opportunities for clinicians to engage as teachers, mentors, tutors and researchers as a way of ensuring the future of the medical profession in regional, rural and remote Queensland.
