Hospital Facilities

The Caboolture Hospital is a 395 bed Hospital (including Mental Health). Our Directorate includes Caboolture Hospital, Woodford Correctional Centre and Kilcoy Hospital.

Outreach services include Caboolture Child and Young People's Mental Health and Caboolture Adult Mental Health Services.

In 2023 Caboolture Hospital opened its new 5 Storey Clinical Services Building which included the delivery of a new expanded Emergency Department, new operating theatres, new Palliative Care, Geriatric, Cardiac Care and Medical wards and a new Intensive Care Unit.

Further redevelopment of the existing main hospital building in 2024 is ongoing and due to be completed by the end of the year.

- **Relocation**

Relocation reimbursement requests for those moving greater than 100kms to work at Caboolture Hospital are approved at the discretion of our Executive Director.
