### Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Hospital (QEII)

QEII is a medium-sized hospital with 220 beds with an additional 44 beds offsite and more than 1700 staff. QEII provides a range of inpatient and outpatient services and has a state-of-the-art Emergency Department that attends to just under 60,000 patients per annum. Currently QEII is undergoing an expansion project to add another 112-bed specialised surgical facility by 2027 to assist with future growth and become the premier surgical hospital for Metro South Health.



QEII is in Coopers Plains which is a family friendly suburb only 13 km from Brisbane's central business district. With excellent retail and shopping facilities and with numerous public transport options many employees of QEII choose to live in the area.
