About the Role

The purpose of this role is to provide specialist acute geriatric care to frail older who present to the Emergency Department via a consultation shared-care model, or at the request of the general practitioner, in the residential aged care facility. This role is accredited with ACEM training requirements as a special skills placement in Geriatric Emergency Medicine.

- Provide supervised medical care to frail older patients, community dwelling and residents of aged care facilities who present to the Caboolture Hospital Emergency both directly and indirectly in partnership with Caboolture Hospital Emergency Department staff.
- Ensure appropriate investigation, management, and disposition for patients under the care of the GEDI-RADAR team.
- Undertake clinical procedures necessary for the care of your patients within the scope of your experience and training.
- Ensure comprehensive, accurate and concise clinical documentation for patients under your care.
- Ensure high level verbal and/or written communication with all parties relevant to the provision of care for your patients, including clinicians, clerical staff, and family members.
- Work collaboratively with other MNHHS RADAR Services.
- At the request of the General practitioner, visit and assess residents of aged care facilities with a view to providing support for the general practitioner to facilitate best care for these patients.
- Participate in all relevant scheduled education sessions.
- Participate in relevant GEDI-RADAR departmental research, audit and quality activities.
- Maintain ACEM training requirements for special skills term in Geriatric Emergency Medicine.
- Facilitate Telemedicine and Virtual care when appropriate for patients in Aged Care Facilities.
- Work collaboratively with key Allied Health, Nursing and Medical Services to provide quality and continuity of care for older persons presenting to Caboolture Hospital.

Requirements for the role

- It is a condition of employment in this role for the employee to be, and remain, vaccinated against the following vaccine preventable diseases during their employment: measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (chicken pox), pertussis (whooping cough) and hepatitis B.
- Appointment to this position requires proof of qualification and registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA). Certified copies of relevant qualification and registration must be provided to the appropriate supervisor/manager, prior to the commencement of clinical duties.
- As the department provides services for children and adults training, experience or qualifications in both age groups is required.
- Evidence of competency in speaking and communicating in English as demonstrated by having completed the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination and achieving a minimum score of 7 in each of the four components.
- Where eligible and appropriate, the Fellow may participate as a “first on-call” with a supporting Staff Specialist (“second on-call”) for hospital duties.
- Participate in after-hours roster for the Emergency Department. This will include evening.
