

Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) Check

A Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) check is a service provided by the Australian government that allows individuals and organisations to verify the visa status and entitlements of non-citizens in Australia. This check is particularly important for employers to ensure compliance with immigration laws.

Privacy Notice

The Department of Health and Hospital and Health Service/s (referred collectively as 'Queensland Health') are collecting your information in accordance with s47 of the *Public Sector Act 2022* to meet its obligations for ensuring compliance with Australian immigration laws. Personal information collected by Queensland Health is handled in accordance with the *Information Privacy Act 2009*. The personal information provided by you will be used by Queensland Health, and/or its authorised migration agents to verify your working rights in Australia, using the Australian Government's Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) system. The personal information provided by you may be disclosed by the recruitment panel and/or human resources department to areas within the Queensland public sector health system (including the Department of Health and Hospital and Health Services), and relevant Australian Government agencies for the purpose of ensuring compliance with Australian immigration laws. Your personal information will not be disclosed to other third parties without consent unless the disclosure is authorised or required by or under law. If you are being considered for employment at Queensland Health and choose not to provide your personal information, your application for employment will not be considered further by Queensland Health. If you are a Queensland Health employee and choose not to provide your personal information, Queensland Health may terminate your employment if it is determined that you are ineligible under s47(1) to be a public sector employee.
