Hospital Facilities

The Caboolture Hospital is a 302 bed Hospital (including Mental Health). Our Directorate includes Caboolture Hospital, Woodford Correctional Centre and Kilcoy Hospital.

Outreach services include Caboolture Child and Young People's Mental Health and Caboolture Adult Mental Health Services.

In 2023 Caboolture Hospital opened its new 5 Storey Clinical Services Building which included the delivery of a new expanded Emergency Department, new operating theatres, new Palliative Care, Geriatric, Cardiac Care and Medical wards and a new Intensive Care Unit.

Further redevelopment of the existing main hospital building in 2024 is ongoing and due to be completed by the end of the year.

Metro North Health:

You may be asked to work across locations in Metro North including RBWH, TPCH, Redcliffe Hospital, Virtual Ward, Surgical Treatment and Rehabilitation Service (STARS), a new 182 bed specialist public health facility located on the Herston Campus offering specialist rehabilitation, elective surgery and endoscopy procedural services.

Multi-storey carpark

- Approximately 1,080 parking spaces in a mix of multi-storey and at-grade facilities
- Accessible parking spaces, electric vehicle charging bays and motorcycle parking
- Combined with other car spaces around the site, there will be approximately 1640 spaces in total across the Caboolture Hospital site
