

# Queensland Cardiology AT Network Pathway guide

## RMO and Registrar Campaign 2026

For the RMO campaign 2026, there will be two distinct processes for advanced training in Cardiology. The Prince Charles Hospital will this year be advertising and recruiting their Cardiology AT positions separate to the Cardiology AT Network Pathway.

1. To apply for an advanced training position with the **Queensland Cardiology Advanced Training Network Pathway**, you must complete the Cardiology network pathway section (Pathway 1) of the RMO application and select any of the 7 major teaching hospitals participating in the network; **and** at **Step 10: Preferences** select 'College/Pathway/Network,' see instructions below.
2. To apply for an advanced training position with **The Prince Charles Hospital**, at **Step 10: Preferences** and select 'The Prince Charles Hospital' as a preference. Please refer to [The Prince Charles Hospital AT Cardiology guide](#).
3. To apply for an advanced training position to both the Cardiology AT Network Pathway and The Prince Charles Hospital, please complete steps 1 and 2 above, and at **Step 10: Preferences**, select 'College/Pathway/network' or 'The Prince Charles Hospital' as first preference with the alternate option as their second preference.

Candidates wishing to be considered for a cardiology AT position at The Prince Charles Hospital **ONLY**, do not need to complete the Cardiology network pathway section but must preference 'The Prince Charles Hospital' at Step 10: Preferences.

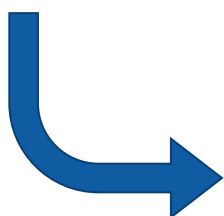
## Facilities participating in the network
