The Internship Year

The internship year consists of five (5) terms of 10–12 weeks.

Leave entitlements

Taken as a block of five (5) weeks per year.

Rotation request

Except for meeting requirements of Rural Generalist Training (RGT), matching of vocational pathway / career aspirations is reserved for PGY2 and beyond.

Medical Education

An extensive post-graduate education program is offered:

- Twice weekly Junior Doctor Education sessions
- Intern and Junior Doctor focused department / unit education programs
- ECG workshops, Advanced Life Support, Plastering demonstrations.
