

Maleny Soldiers Memorial Hospital

Maleny Soldiers Memorial Hospital (MSMH) is one of the five hospitals within the Sunshine Coast Hospital and Health Service. MSMH provides emergency, acute and sub-acute care to Maleny and the surrounding hinterland communities as well as to the broader health service. Maleny Hospital is in a rural location and is classified a small rural town (MM5). MSMH provides a vital health service function to the local community with a range of services from Clinical Services Capability Framework Level 1 to Level 3. The hospital has 24 inpatients beds as well as 2 emergency beds, including 1 resuscitation bed, and 3 clinic rooms.

MSMH is accredited through the Australian College of Rural Remote Medicine and the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners for secondary care. You will be supported by experienced Rural Generalists with a variety of Advance Specialist Training to work in a rural environment and become an expert in the rural context. Positions are available both full time and part time.
