Caboolture Hospital underwent a major expansion and redevelopment in 2023. This delivered a new Clinical Services Building, which included new Operating Theatres, a new Emergency Medicine Department, a new Intensive Care Unit and several new medical wards. This much needed expansion continued in 2024 and 2025 with redevelopment projects occurring in the main hospital building, these works have enabled the expansion of health services provided by Caboolture Hospital to our growing community.

Rotations

Every effort is made to provide resident medical officers with rotations that match their vocational pathway or career aspirations with each medical year is divided in 5 terms. Leave is allocated in a block of 5 weeks annual leave. Terms:

Education Support

Education is a key part of your internship journey, in order to support your continued development Caboolture Hospital offers:

Weekly education programs for interns and junior doctors linked to your continued professional development.





- 1 hour per week of Prevocational Education Foundation (protected time for interns)
- 1 hour per week of Prevocational Education Extension (protected time for interns and JHOs)
- On-site Education and Skills Development Centre.
- Simulation centre, linked to the Clinical Skills Development Services.
- Weekly Grand Rounds.
- Unit specific learning programs, including bedside teaching, department education, case presentations.

Caboolture Hospital also has a very supportive and encouraging Medical Education Unit (MEU). The team are always available and willing to provide advocacy and support.

The MEU actively promotes its open-door policy. We provide support specific to your needs, be it in relation to a personal or professional matter. In addition, we meet with you on a regular basis to ensure your training program is progressing satisfactorily. We continually monitor your training program to ensure you are provided the best environment to learn and reach your personalised learning objectives.

Orientation

A 1-week (paid) program welcoming you to the team and ensuring compliance with all mandatory training requirements.
