# First Core Year of Advanced Training for Gastroenterology

### **Logan Beaudesert Health Service - General Information**

Metro South Health (MSH) is a major provider of health services in Queensland. It has a catchment area that spans 3,806 square kilometres and covers areas from the Brisbane River in the north, to Redland City in the east (encompassing the Southern Moreton Bay Islands), to Logan City and the eastern portion of the Scenic Rim. The health service's estimated population is almost 1.3 million people and caters to a wide demographic of people.

MSH delivers public health services in the Brisbane south side, Logan, Redlands and Scenic Rim regions including teaching, research, community and specialty services. MSH is also the provider of a number of statewide services to Queenslanders from across the State. More than 20,000 staff work for MSH.

#### **Logan Hospital Gastroenterology Team**

The Department of Gastroenterology provides inpatient and outpatient care for adult patients with a wide spectrum of gastroenterological issues. In addition to General Gastroenterology, we have consultants dedicated to Interventional Endoscopy, Hepatology and Inflammatory Bowel Disease within the team.

We perform a wide range of interventional procedures including gastroscopy, colonoscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, ERCP, EUS, EMR, and capsule endoscopy. We also offer Fibroscan for Hepatology patients at both Logan Hospital and Eight Mile Plains Satellite Health Centre.

Educational opportunities include weekly Gastroenterology Journal Club, weekly Grand Rounds, Histopathology MDT, Radiology MDT, IBD MDT, and HCC MDT (with PAH). There are research opportunities available depending on individual trainee interest.

During 1st year core training, there will be dedicated opportunities to manage patients with the entire breadth of diagnoses in Gastroenterology and Hepatology, in both the inpatient and outpatient setting.

There will be a minimum of 2 endoscopy training lists per week supervised by rotating experienced endoscopists, with the opportunity to perform emergency procedures during and after hours.

There is an expectation that the 1<sup>st</sup> year AT will lead the other Registrars/PHOs and be responsible for the weekly on-call roster. Currently, this is a 1:4 weekly roster. There is 24-hour consultant coverage for emergency endoscopy.

The inpatient gastroenterology service will be supported by a rotating Basic Physician Trainee and 2 RMO staff. There is a dedicated Consultant to supervise and support the inpatient team. There is a separate Consult Registrar/PHO responsible for inpatient consults throughout the hospital.
