

Logan Hospital – First Core Year in Advanced Training for Gastroenterology

The Logan Hospital Department of Gastroenterology provides inpatient and outpatient care for adult patients with a wide spectrum of Gastrointestinal and Liver Diseases. There are opportunities for the management of inflammatory bowel disease, viral hepatitis, autoimmune liver disease, interventional endoscopy patients and general gastroenterology. There is 24-hour consultant coverage for emergency endoscopy.

The trainee and resident will manage a small inpatient gastroenterology service as well as providing consultation on inpatients throughout the hospital. There will be minimum 2, usually 3 endoscopy training lists per week with the opportunity to perform emergency procedures.

The trainee is expected to participate in training of medical students, residents and basic trainee registrars. There are weekly radiology and fortnightly histology review meetings. Journal club and Research Meetings are held monthly. The trainee is expected to complete a research project of their choice such as clinical research study or clinical audit with preparation of an abstract and manuscript.
