| <b>Service benefits (drawcard)</b>                     | <p>Caboolture Hospital is a general hospital with a core clinical activity being general medicine. It is a busy general medicine facility with approximately 160 inpatients on a day-to-day basis with a very active specialist outpatients department. There are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 6 General Medicine teams.</li> <li>- 1 Cardiology team who looks after an 8-bed CCU. The rotation provides a weekly ECHO teaching session and opportunity to assist in TOE, DCCV and stress testing.</li> <li>- 1 Respiratory team who offers the opportunity to advance in pleural drain insertion and management skills.</li> <li>- 1 Acute Geriatric team who looks after a secure dementia ward with 8 beds.</li> <li>- 1 GEM team who looks after 15 beds.</li> <li>- 1 Stroke team, stroke registrar takes stroke calls during office hours under direct supervision of local Stroke physician.</li> <li>- 1 Infectious Diseases consult team run by a local ID physician with 1 clinic per week.</li> <li>- 1 Neurology consult team with 3 clinic per week run by our local Neurology specialist.</li> </ul> |          |       |                                |  |                   |  |                                   |   |                   |  |                            |  |             |  |              |  |                              |                |                  |                |                 |                |                    |                |              |                |     |                |

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|                          | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1 Endocrine consult team who provides inpatient consult services for medical and surgical teams, including Maternal Health consults in the Obstetric ward. Registrar has access to 4 clinics per week including a general Endocrine clinic, a Diabetes clinic and Maternal Health clinic.</li> </ul> <p>The catchment area is about 180,000 people in various age groups (from 16 to over 100 years of age). The hospital is affiliated to UQ Medical School and has a number of medical students on each rotation. The department of medicine organises FRACP exams every year and is very active in the education of its trainees. We have a very busy MDU set-up providing access to robust acute care medicine experience.</p> <p>The outpatient service is well developed and currently growing within community based chronic disease management. There is considerable emphasis within the health service on developing integrated care models across the region.</p> <p>GCH is a tertiary centre with a range of medical subspecialties which are at the forefront of contemporary practice. General Medicine advanced trainees will rotate to these subspecialties filling agreed advanced trainee level positions.
