Greenslopes Private Hospital (GPH) is Australia's largest private teaching hospital. It is a 697-bed, tertiary level facility operated by Ramsay Health Care on the south side of Brisbane. GPH is a Level 3 teaching hospital which has a long and distinguished history of providing training to doctors from intern to Advanced Trainees. Teaching facilities include a centrally located library with JMO lounge, Simulation Centre, Conference Rooms and access to free Wi-Fi.

The hospital prides itself on being an institution which prioritises its staff's wellbeing and is dedicated to providing excellent patient care. - Comprehensive oncology services including 39 chair day oncology, radiotherapy and PET Scan
