

WBA - Workplace based assessment

Program overview

The Workplace Based Assessment (WBA) program offered at Darling Downs Health is a minimum 12-month assessment program run as an alternative to the AMC 2 Clinical Examination. Assessments are completed at the level of PGY 1 / intern.

On successful completion of the program a certificate is issued by AMC providing a step towards general registration.

Darling Downs Health aim to take 10 candidates throughout the year. Number of intakes is twice per year currently.

As per the AMC exam, assessments are in the disciplines of:

- Adult Medicine
- Adult Surgery
- Child Health
- Emergency Medicine
- Mental Health
- Women's Health

Summative assessments across all disciplines are:

12 Mini-CEX	Must pass 9 (Passes in history taking, physical examination and counselling / patient education domains)
6 Case based discussions	Must pass 5
1 in training assessment (ITA)	Must be satisfactory
2 Multi-source feedback	Must be satisfactory

Applying for WBA

To be eligible for the WBA Program, you must have passed the AMC CAT MCQ and current IELTS/OET/PTE English examination result and be an employee with Darling Downs Health.

You need to be employed as a PGY2/+ Prevocational doctor and complete a minimum of 2 x (10 week) satisfactory terms/rotations.

Requests for EOIs for the WBA program will be sent to current eligible (having completed 6 months) Darling Downs Health employees who hold Limited Registration with AHPRA. EOI will request a completed application form, cover letter, resume, 2 referee reports and 2 satisfactory work performance forms from Darling Downs Health. Applications also require recommendation from your current supervisor.

Applying for Prevocational Junior Doctor positions with Darling Downs Health

Applications for Prevocational doctor positions will be considered through the annual RMO campaign online portal and also through expressions of interest to Medical Workforce -

All applications will be merit listed and only successful candidates will be contacted. Applications will remain current for 12 months.
