Preference QARTS Rotations

QARTS is divided into four groups of rotations, termed Central, Gold Coast, Northern and Southern. In each rotation there are Core, Metropolitan and Regional facilities. QARTS registrars are expected to accept the rotation they are offered.



Step 2: Indicate your first and second preference hospital within that rotation.




Only choose rotations you are willing to accept. If you refuse a position in a rotation you have preferenced, you will not be offered another position during the 2025 HEY. It is not a requirement to preference all four rotations however it may limit your opportunity. Regional placement is expected and compulsory and an integral part of your training.

Please note that you must preference at least two rotations where you are willing to accept a position. If you do not want to preference a third and fourth rotation, please select 'Not preferred.'

Step 1: Indicate your first, second, third and fourth rotation in order of personal preference:




Step 2: Indicate your first and second preference hospitals within the rotation preference, refer to facilities below:



RMO Application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, to be considered by the **QARTS program**, you **MUST** complete your first preference as follow. If you do not allocate 'Anaesthesia' as your 1st preference, you will not be considered by the QARTS program:



You have 5 preferences available to use for positions, it is recommended that you utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions you may be interested in if you are not selected to your preferred position.
