1. Go to the National Hand Hygiene Initiative Learning Management System: <https://nhhi.southrock.com/cgi-bin-secure/Home.cgi>.
2. If this is your first time accessing training, click on “Register new profile”.

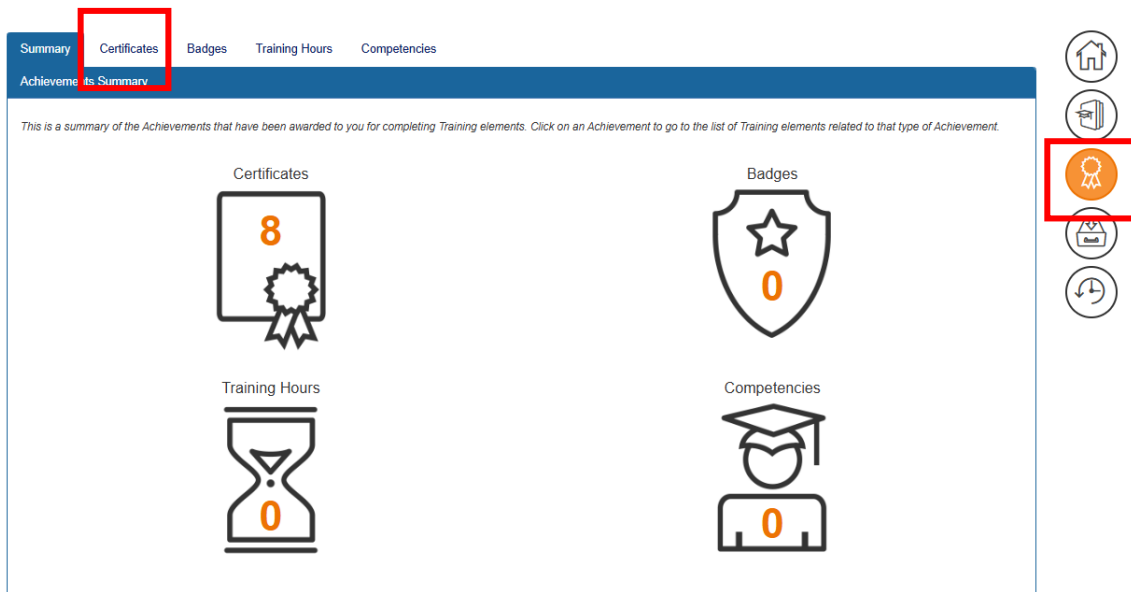
